- 7. Make your merry way through our NEW Mistletoe Maze,** located next to our Alight at Night Ferris Wheel! Snow or no snow, this new family-fun snow-block-style maze will be up for the duration of the festival, made up of over 300 giant white-wrapped bales of Reindeer Hay! You may find yourself under a Mistletoe sprig or two along its 400 foot long path!
- 8. Eat, Drink and be Merry!** Plan to stop at one of our restaurants for holiday dining. From snacks to full course traditional turkey dinners, we have an option to suit every palate.
