## **POLICIES FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE** *(please read the following carefully)*

1. We expect all families to make a financial contribution to their child's camp experience.
2. Applications must be complete with all the required information attached before you can be placed on a candidate list for assistance. We cannot be responsible for incorrect forms.
3. All applications are dealt with on a first come, first served basis. We do our best to help as many children as possible, however we are unable to guarantee any one financial assistance.
4. Any number of children from a single family can be assisted.
5. To ensure we help as many individual children as possible benefit from an Upper Canada Village experience, we are unable to assist families for more than two year in a row.
6. To help us process your application, interviews may be arranged to discuss your financial situation and to agree on a suitable level of assistance.
7. We will notify you of the status of your application by telephone or mail as soon as possible.
